The Program is designed to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the people of and partner nations. The Fulbright U.S. Student Program offers grants for one academic year to U.S. graduating college seniors, graduate students, early-career professionals, and artists. Participants pursue graduate or professional study, advanced research, or English teaching in elementary and secondary schools or colleges and universities. Each year, over 2,200 Americans receive grants from the Fulbright U.S. Student Program to travel to more than 140 countries
